TOWN OF WARWICK
LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE
CODE OF THE TOWN OF WARWICK

A Local Law amending Chapter 127 of the Code of the Town of Warwick in relation to Sanitary Sewer User Charges by changing Section 127-5 of Chapter 127, as more fully set forth below:

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Warwick, Orange County, New York, as follows:

Section 1 –TOWN CODE AMENDED:

The Town of Warwick Town Code is hereby amended by replacing the current Section 127-5 in its entirety with a new Section 127-5 thereto to read as follows:

§ 127-5 Billing of charges; penalty for late payment; tax lien; final reading.

A. All users shall be billed quarterly. Billings for any particular quarter shall be made within 20 days after the end of the billing. Payments are due within 20 days after the end of the period. Any payment not received within 30 days after the end of the billing shall be delinquent. The Town Supervisor is hereby authorized and designated to receive and collect all charges and other fees payable to the Town pursuant to this Chapter.

B. A late payment penalty of 1.5% of the user charge bill will be added to each delinquent bill for each 30 days or portion thereof of delinquency. When any bill is more than 90 days in default, such bill shall be presented to the County of Orange for payment and said bill will then become part of the county tax lien on said property.

C. Final sewer reading charge: \$40.

Section 2. – This Local Law will take effect upon the filing of same with the New York State Secretary of State.
