4. We are currently selling hunting and fishing licenses for the 2020-21 season. They are on sale in the Clerk’s Office and the deer management permits are available until October 1st.

SUPERVISORS REPORT

1. Obviously, everyone is aware we had a pretty devastating storm that brought down a lot of power lines in the Town of Warwick which was one of the hardest hit areas. Clearly O&R’s response was perplexing to say the least to many. Residents were very frustrated with not being able to get through to O&R and getting information. We tried to fill that gap as best as we could, we got more successful once we got an O&R person stationed in our 24-hour dispatch station. We were able to get some direction to crews to get people up and running. O&R did provide a dry ice drop one day with their personnel and they gave us additional dry ice and myself, Commissioner Astorino and two DPW workers Mike Holt and John Morse distributed on Saturday for residents and they were appreciative of that. The Orange County Association of Towns, Villages and Cities which we are members of have requested meeting with O&R’s Senior Staff to understand their response effort and how they can improve it going forward. I will say O&R is reimbursing

residents who were out of power for more than 48 hours for lost medicines and perishable foods. There is a form that you can fill out on oru.com/residents, so you should look to that to try and get some reimbursement. The other outcome of the storm is that we did reopen the brush pile at Union Corners Park for residents to bring downed tree limbs out there and we will have them chipped up and that will be open until the end of August.

2. Coronavirus Update, I just want to let residents know I did talk to the administration at St. Anthony's and there are no current Covid patients at St. Anthony's which is a good thing. Our rate of positive in Warwick has been stable for several weeks and fortunately we have not had any deaths in several months. I think people in Warwick are doing the things they need to do by avoiding large crowds and they are wearing their masks and being responsible. We appreciate that residents are doing that.

3. Our Community Preservation Fund receipts for July were \$68,070.94 and it brings the total in the fund to \$3,652,265.54, so again it was a good month. It reflects that properties continue to sell here in Warwick as we are seeing that in the Hudson Valley in Orange County with homes being sold by people who are seeking respite from the craziness further south of us.

4. I would like to let the public know that we will be entering the Budget Process a little earlier this year. We know that the sales tax revenues for this year are down. We already know that number will be \$350,000 to \$400,000 for us and we have to find that in this year's budget and we've already made some provisions to do that, but it will make next year's budgeting a little more challenging. We will get those sheets out to the departments and work with the department heads to make that work for everybody.

5. The journal entries were made with the Comptroller and they were in order and we signed off on it.

WHEREAS, a resolution was duly adopted by the Town Board on the 25th day of June, 2020, reciting the foregoing and specifying July 16, 2020 at 7:15 P.M., as the time, and the Town Hall, 132 Kings Highway, New York, as the place, where the said Board would meet to consider the formation of the District and to hear all persons interested in the subject thereof concerning the

same; and

WHEREAS, such order was duly posted and published and served as required by law; and

WHEREAS, a hearing in the matter was duly held by the Town Board on July 16, 2020 commencing at or after 7:15 P.M., in the Town Hall, 132 Kings Highway, New York and discussion upon the matter having been had and all persons desiring to be heard having been duly heard,

NOW THEREFORE, upon the evidence given at such hearing, it is

RESOLVED AND DETERMINED THAT:

1. That the creation and construction of this lighting district will not have a negative impact on the environment;
2. That the formation of the proposed lighting district is a Type 2 action under SEQRA;
3. That all the property and property owners within the proposed lighting district are benefited thereby;
4. All the property and property owners benefited are included within the limits of the proposed district; and
5. It is in the public interest to form the lighting district.
6. That the establishment of the district as proposed in the Map, Plan and Report be approved, and that such district shall be designated and known as the "Warwick Valley Office & Technology Corporate Park Lighting District" and that such district shall be bounded and described as set forth in the aforesaid Map, Plan and Report, all such lands and territory therein described are situate within the Town of Warwick and outside of any incorporated village or city; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board declares the establishment of District to be a Type 2 action under SEQRA; and

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Warwick hereby establishes a lighting District known as the "Warwick Valley Office & Technology Corporate Park Lighting District" in the in the area described in the Map, Plan and Report, as more particularly described in Schedule A annexed hereto;

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Clerk of Orange County for recording, together with all appropriate papers with appropriate signatures where needed; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is directed to file a certified copy in duplicate of this resolution with the Office of the State Department of Audit and Control at Albany, New York, together with all appropriate papers with appropriate signatures where needed;

RESOLVED, that all expenses attended upon the formation of this District shall be the responsibility of the owners of the premises within the District.

RESOLVED, All boards, agencies, departments, and contracted professionals of the Town of Warwick are hereby authorized and directed to effect or otherwise facilitate the implementation of said District; and it is further

RESOLVED, that this Resolution is subject to permissive referendum and that the Town Clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to duly file and post a Notice of Adoption of Resolution subject to Permissive Referendum.

Motion Carried (4 ayes, 0 nays & 1 absent, Councilman Gerstner absent) Supervisor declared this resolution duly adopted.

Motion Carried (4 ayes, 0 nays & 1 absent, Councilman Gerstner absent) Supervisor declared this resolution duly adopted.


